

AVERYHILL SUMMER CAMP INFORMATION

HOURS

- Camp programming runs Monday to Friday **9am to 4pm**.
- Drop off and pick up will be done just inside the gates to the farm and parents will not be able to enter the camp setting. Daily temperature and symptom checks must be performed at home prior to each camp day and a daily screening form will need to be signed by a parent each morning.
- Drop off & pick up times: Campers **10 years of age or older** must be dropped off from **8:30-8:45am** and picked up from **4:15-4:30pm**. Campers **9 years of age or younger** must be dropped off from **8:45-9:00am** and picked up from **4:00-4:15pm**. In the case of siblings, parents may choose the more appropriate time.
- Early drop off (8am-8:30am) and late pick up (4:30pm-5pm) will still be available however campers will be required to stay in a designated area and must bring a quiet activity (ie. a book to read).

PACKING LIST

- Dress for an active, outdoor program (t-shirt, shorts, and running shoes).
- Wear a mask or face covering and pack extra masks for switching throughout the day.
- Long pants may be preferred for riding. Campers are encouraged to bring their own riding helmet but if they need to borrow a helmet one will be assigned for the week. All campers are required to bring their own boots (must have a distinct heel). These do not have to be proper riding boots, any boot with a heel is sufficient.
- Pencil case for art with the following suggested supplies- pencil, eraser, crayons/pencil crayons/markers, scissors and glue. Campers will also need a 100% cotton item (ie. t-shirt, pillow case) for tie dye day. Campers will be informed which day to bring this item.
- Swimsuit and towel (in a separate bag to reduce the need for backpacks in the changing area). Campers may also wish to bring flip flops, goggles, and floaties if needed.
- Clothing to cover up in case of mosquitoes in the woods.
- Bug spray, sunscreen, and hat.
- All activities go rain or shine so please bring a raincoat and boots on rainy days.
- Please note that no personal items may be shared between campers so please make sure that each camper has their own bug spray, sunscreen, etc.

LUNCH

- Please send a peanut-free lunch, snacks, and drinks every day.
- Please note that there are no water fountains at the farm. We will sell cold bottled water (\$0.50 each) that must be poured into the camper's reusable water bottle.
- There will be absolutely no sharing of food between campers.

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

- All campers must wear a mask or face covering at all times indoors and when physical distancing cannot be maintained outdoors.
- Group requests (ie. siblings/friends in the same group) must be communicated by the **Friday** prior to your camp week. Absolutely no group changes can occur once our program has started for the week. Please be aware that it is difficult to put children that are more than 2 years apart in the same group and still make the program relevant and safe for everyone.
- **IMPORTANT**- Any camper with a fever or any typical or atypical symptoms of COVID-19 is required to stay home. If a camper begins to experience symptoms of COVID-19 while attending camp they will be immediately separated from others in a supervised area. A parent will be notified and it is expected that the camper will be picked up immediately. Any camper that stays home or needs to be sent home due to sickness of any kind will be required to stay home for the remainder of the week and a full refund for the remaining days will be given.
